The name Kuala Langat originated from its position at the estuary of Sungai Langat. "Air Hangat" means lukewarm water in the Minangkabau dialect. Initial traders who used this river as their trade route found the mouth of the river water to be constantly warm. Some say the selangat fish caught from this river strengthened the rationale behind the name.

Kuala Langat district is known for its beautiful beaches like Kelanang and Morib. While you are here, stay a night or two at the homestay and Riverine Hotel, enjoy the water theme park or simply just sit down and unwind by the beach.

At Jugra Hill, visitors can view historical relics from the time of the Sultan of Selangor's reign and if you are up for an adventure, give tandem paragliding experience a try from the hill.



Visit Paya Indah Wetlands for a fun-filled day with the sighting of a good deal of wildlife like crocodiles, hippos, rare migratory birds and many more. With so many activities await, you will go home packed with memorable moments. If you would like to see various species of hornbills, Sungai Karang Forest Reserve Hornbill Observatory Centre will be your best bet.

Kuala Langat also has a spot for sailing enthusiasts to congregate and hone their skills in handling yachts. If you are not keen on sailing, fret not just sit down and enjoy the sea view. The indigenous people's settlement (Orang Asli settlement) at Carey Island and the Malay villages that are rich in local culture and traditions are also worth visiting.

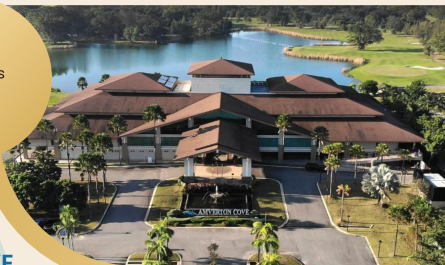


SIME DARBY PLANTATION ECOGARDENS

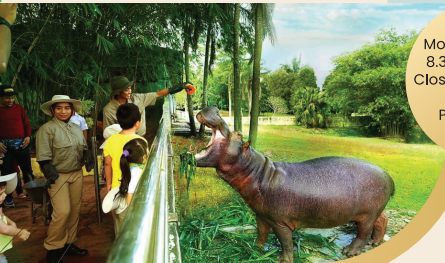

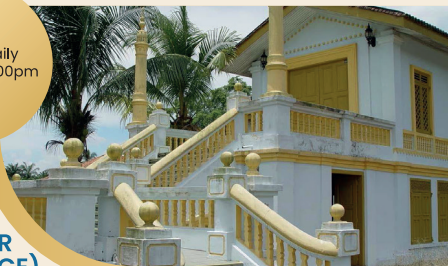

SULTAN ALAEDDIN ROYAL MOSQUE

Sultan Alaeddin Royal Mosque is also known as Masjid Alauddin or Masjid Bandar. The mosque was built in the early 1900s about 200 meters from Istana Bandar (Bandar Palace), the residence of the fifth Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sir Alaeddin Sulaiman Shah, GCMG KCVO. A fine example of classic Moorish and Mughal architecture, the mosque shares several similarities with another heritage landmark, the Sultan Abdul Samad Building in Kuala Lumpur, particularly in its domes and arches. Sultan Alaeddin Royal Mosque's interior is decorated with Qur'anic inscriptions and intricate wood carvings.

ISTANA BANDAR (BANDAR PALACE)

Istana Bandar Jugra belongs to Sultan Sir Alaeddin Sulaiman Shah, the fifth Sultan of Selangor. He lived here for many years until his death in 1938. His grandson, Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who was to be the eight Sultan of Selangor, was born in the palace in 1926. The double-storey structure has many rooms, including a royal bath (Kolam Mandi Diraja), throne room (Balai Rong Seri), banquet room (Kamar Santap Diraja), bedrooms (Kamar Beradu), audience halls (Balai Mengadap), verandah (Sotoh), kitchen (Dapur) and a "forbidden garden" (Taman Larangan). Also known as Istana Alaeddin or Alaeddin Palace, the building was constructed using high-quality cengal timber and marble. Its design is largely Islamic, mainly of Indian and Middle-Eastern origin.

FO GUANG SHAN DON ZEN TEMPLE

The FGS Dong Zen Temple is well-known for its elaborate Lantern and Flora Festival, a kaleidoscope of digital lights, lanterns and flotillas that illuminate the temple grounds during the annual Chinese New Year celebrations, which last 15 day.

Its vast and peaceful compound comprises a main shrine that houses a giant Buddha, Garden, Sutra calligraphy hall, the Dong Zen Institute of Buddhist Studies, Fo Guang Yuan Art Gallery and exhibition halls. The temple also organizes short monastic retreats, meditation camps, prayer services and regular Dharma talks.

PARAGLIDING AT JUGRA HILL

Paragliding at Jugra Hill is gaining popularity among the local paragliders as well as the tourists. This recreational and competitive adventure sport has become a must-try experience for anyone who'd come to Bukit Jugra. The flying site is located in Jugra, a historical town in Kuala Langat that exudes an old-world charm with its stately buildings, bridges and roads. Back in the late 1800s, Jugra was the royal capital of Selangor; its well-preserved buildings are good examples of the artistry and grandeur of its glamorous past. Bukit Jugra was known to foreign navigators and cartographers as Parcelar Hill.

Today, Bukit Jugra or Jugra Hill is still very much a popular venue, albeit for different reasons. Its undulating terrain and scenic views make it an excellent spot for outdoor activities, such as hiking, paragliding & downhill trikes. If you are into for some thrill & adrenaline experiences, Bukit Jugra is a great choice of destination.

MAH MERI CULTURAL VILLAGE, CAREY ISLAND

There is a small gallery/museum and traditional house in the village compound that is open to visitors.

The village is open throughout the year, but the best time to visit Pulau Carey's Mah Meri Cultural Village is during Hari Moyang (Ancestor Day), which takes place around March or April each year, Puja Pantai (Oceanic Healing) or during a wedding ceremony.

During the festival, the tribesmen and women wear intricately carved masks and perform the mystifying Tarian Jo-oh (Jungle Dance) and Tarian Topeng (Mask Dance), which are main features of the festival repertoire.

Genuine crafts purchased at the Cultural Village or National Museum bear the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) Seal of Excellence and come with a certificate of authenticity.
